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

An effective minister must have a strong feeling, even a blessed assurance, that you have been called into ministry. The call cannot be entered into by "your own choice," but rather, your "no other choice." Can you positively say, "I know this is my destiny?"

- He will know the timing

Prophetic

- Visions, dreams and spiritual signs
- A prophetic Word spoken over you

Proven

- Becomes conclusive
- Validation by Elders (District Board)

 - What is a reasonable time table to attempt.







Humility is realizing you are totally dependent upon God. You do not have to debase yourself, put yourself down, act unlearned or pretend to be unqualified to be humble. - □ The most basic attitude of ministry. The soul of ministry.
- □ It is not putting your self down or low self esteem.
- It determines how your ministry is received by others.
- The focus is "Humble Yourself" not "others!"

Holiness

- □ The ministry is sacred.
- Your personal life of separation and consecration will dramatically impact every aspect of your ministry.

Honesty

- Speak the truth in love.
- Live the truth in public.
- Love the truth always.

Honorable

- The ministry is a sacred trust, treat it with respect and dignity.
- Be ethical in relations with other ministers.
- Show respect to the message and to the men who validated your ministry.

Heroic

- Be willing to forsake all.
- Go the second mile.





Humility

Pray For Favor with God and Man

Key Application Points

- Pray for God to open doors in your ministry.
- Compliment other ministries. Compliment them personally and in front of others.
- Do not defend yourself. Hold your peace and let the Lord fight your battles.
- Examine your speech, attitude and dress. Is there anything in these that project pride?
- Do something you think will please God.
- Do something you think will please your pastor.

The Process of Ministry is Serving

Go The Extra Mile!

- Key Application Points
 - Go out of your way to assist someone with a need.
 - Purposefully and mindfully embrace the concept of self denial as a major defining aspect of ministry.
 - Actively engage yourself in three basic levels of serving, realizing that serving people is the highest calling.
 - Serve the Lord
 - Serve the Ministry
 - Serve the People
 - Help someone who has no way of helping you in return. This is a selfless form of serving.

The Purpose of Ministry is People

Spend Time With People

- If you do not like to spend time with people, ministry will be a struggle for you. The focus of ministry is people. They are the end result of everything.
- Time is everyone's most valuable asset. When you give time to people this speaks volumes about your concern for them.

Willing To Help People

- Ministry that is not focused on the needs of people will soon become sterile and ultimately unnecessary!
- If you are unwilling to be inconvenienced by people you should not be in the ministry.

Encourage People

- **D** This is genuine ministry. Speak a word of encouragement.
- When the Lord directs the word, it is a word of prophecy.
- Speak hope, faith and courage. Provide a smile!

Pray For People

Perhaps the most valuable treasure you could ever give someone is the gift of prayer. Honestly praying for their need is a treasure.

Share With People

A unique attribute of Christians is their willingness to share their blessings with each other. This is especially valuable in ministry.





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Focus On The Altar Service

Key Application Points

- Pray for at least one person in every altar service.
- Stay around after the service and talk with people, speaking words of encouragement.
- Use greeting cards and thank you notes to express encouragement.
- Pray for the people you know are in need and then let them know you have prayed for them.
- Attend a wedding, funeral, graduation or birthday celebration.


Suffering



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The Power Of Ministry Through Suffering

- Your Savior, my Savior was a suffering Savior. He came, He suffered and He died on your behalf. You have access to great victory because of His suffering. Your suffering, as a Christian will develop your call of God and reveal your gifting. This process is not easy, but it is very rewarding.
- The Lord's call to discipleship requires one to first deny himself, then take up his cross to follow Jesus. This continues to be the expectation of all ministers.







Enduring Hurt

- Our salvation message is very powerful, yet you will have to endure hurt. Meditate on this statement - the blood deals with the "sin," the cross deals with the "sinner."
- The pain of betrayal and rejection is a valuable asset in terms of ministry development. You will learn to trust the LORD as your deliverer and healer. He will lift you up time and again, restoring you from hurt, and you will be strengthened by the power of that confidence.

Enduring Pressure

Anyone can steer the ship in calm waters. True leadership is learned in the storms.

Enduring Opposition

Settle this now, people will not always agree with you, or even like you. There is a devil and he hates you.

Enduring Necessity

Jesus said that the foxes have holes, and the birds have nests but the son of man has no where to lay His head. There will be times you do not have the resources to accomplish your task. You must depend on the Lord!

Enduring Emptiness

Empty nets are a reality of every ministry endeavor. There are times when you are not being fulfilled in ministry. They will test your faithfulness and determination.





Fasting Is A Great Practice

Key Application Points

Maintain regular seasons of fasting.

- Practice letting the Lord fight your battles and develop a trust in Him regarding your future.
- Pray a prayer of forgiveness concerning the most serious "hurts" you have experienced.
- Although you may not have the material resources you need, make a list of those things you do have and are thankful for.
- Resist bitterness in the area of your greatest sacrifices and areas of personal suffering.

The Maturing Of Ministry is Through Mentoring

- Study to show yourself approved, a workman that needs not to be ashamed. Personal development is an absolute must for a minister. You will minister out of your experiences and your personal relationship with Jesus.
- You may have held a position in ministry for 25 years, but that does not mean you have 25 years of ministry experience. You may have one years experience 25 years in a row!









Academic Knowledge

Study public speaking approaches and techniques.
 Become skillful in your grammar and word usage. Use a dictionary and thesaurus to broaden your vocabulary.

Relationship Knowledge

- Ministers are in the people business, so study people. Develop a good first impression strategy. Work on developing relationships with people who are very different from yourself.
- Develop the art of comforting, encouraging and genuinely complimenting. Develop conflict resolution skills.

Spiritual Knowledge

The ministry is a "spiritual thing." You will be dealing with spiritual opposition personally and in the lives of the people you are trying to help.

Practical Knowledge

There is no substitute for common sense. Develop an ability to keep things simple and realistic in everyday life situations.

Administrative Knowledge

- Basic accounting practices like reading a profit/loss sheet and understanding the balance between assets and liabilities will go a long way. You MUST keep good records!
- Lean about By-Laws and conducting a business meeting according to Robert's Rules Of Order.

Establish Resources For Development

Key Application Points

- Buy books, E-Books, CD's and and DVD's to help you develop knowledge and strengthen your weak areas.
- Focus on 2-3 ministers you relate to and get your hands on their sermons, books, and teaching materials.
- Develop a list of online resources you can visit to continue your personal development.
- When you are in the company of elders and seasoned ministries ask questions and listen more than you speak.

The Unity Of Ministry Through Mutual Respect.

- One of the greatest attributes you could ever develop is respecting the ministry of others. Show respect and honor to other ministers - both elders and peers, even novices coming up in ministry.
- □ The anointing you respect is the anointing you receive.
- The apostles possessed a "Look on us" approach to ministry.







Mutual Respect

Respect Position

You should respect and honor those with leadership offices within the church and the ministerial fellowship. These offices have been setup to provide structure and order within the body of Christ. You will do well to honor the position and those who hold them.

Respect Anointing

The anointing upon a persons life deserves respect and acknowledgement. When God chooses to enable someone for a task He expects us to recognize His will.

Respect Gifting

People with special gifts are often ignored or envied to such a degree they fall prey to destruction. Ministers have a responsibility to protect the operation of the gifts and the gifted.

Respect Diversity

Five ministry offices, nine gifts of the Spirit, nine serving gifts, various administrations, diversities of operations, governments and on and on it goes. No one minister is the same. You will not minister the same; even if you have the same gifting as another, you will have a different operation.

Respect Fruitfulness

You may not like or understand this approach. However, if souls are being won to the Lord and the fruit remains this deserves respect and is needed within the body.





Mutual Respect

Compliment Another Minister

Key Application Points

- Speak well of the ministry, both in their presence and behind their back.
- Show honor to those who have been successful in ministry, bearing fruit.
- Respect and honor the elders.
- Resist a spirit of jealousy toward those who are doing what you feel called to do and perhaps are more successful at it than yourself.
- Recognize the need in ministry that you are unable to perform.



DNA OF MINISTRY Eight Apostolic Principles For Ministry

Mutual Respect

- Name some highly anointed people you admire?
- What are some of the special gifted ministries you have been exposed to? What did you gain from the experience?

- Name a friend in ministry who is very different from yourself in gifting and function.
- Who have you observed in ministry that is fruitful? What kind of fruit if being produced?

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The Fruit Of Ministry Is Disciples.

- Every ministry is designed and destined to bring forth fruit. Fruit is brought forth once the seed is sown and the maturing process has been **completed**.
- Jesus provides an excellent model in this area. He fulfilled His own ministry, as well as calling, through equipping the disciples. Then His disciples carried out His mission to the world!







Disciples

Calling Disciples

- Perhaps one of the most difficult decisions in ministry is choosing those in whom you will invest your time and energy.
- Choose the ones who show true Christian attitude. If they have the basics they will be able to learn the specific functions of ministry.

Training Disciples

Mentoring is Men "touring" other men's lives. You have to let them in. You must spend time with potential disciples.

Empowering Disciples

Jesus said I must go away. The "go away" principle is critical in empowering disciples. They must be given the opportunity to do ministry without your involvement.

Restoring Disciples

The Apostle Peter is perhaps the biggest failure and the biggest success among the disciples. The Lord did not throw him away when he denied Him.

Releasing Disciples

There comes a time when you have to "send them out." Jesus sent them two by two and gave them power in the Spirit. Let them spread their wings, they will innovate, and become a powerful new force of ministry.


- Are you able to identify at least one person you may begin sharing knowledge and imparting to?
