

### You may need to read this material more than once!

We have been overloaded with gimmicks and apparent quick fix growth solutions, especially in the area of evangelism. These short lived results are not sustainable, and often end up causing great harm to the health of the church by demoralizing evangelistic passion and faith.

This is not to say, evangelism and church growth is some difficult, complex process. Yet, the truth remains, spiritual laws cannot be broken or ignored, even in a sincere attempt to fulfill the ministry.

The material here is an attempt to provide a complete examination of the essential elements necessary to initiate and sustain a revival dimension in the local church. A healthy church is a growing church. A healthy church brings souls to the New Birth experience while subsequently establishing them in their walk with God.

The main goal of presenting "THE DNA OF REVIVAL" is to help you set in motion a process that will continue throughout the life of your church. Many of the important elements of the overall process may already be in place. In this case, the information here will help you organize your thoughts and properly observe your process.

# **Building A Revival**

Build – "to construct or create something by assembling all the pieces together properly."

### (Psalms 127:1)

• "Except the LORD build the house, they labour in vain that build it: except the LORD keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain."

### (1 Peter 2:5)

 "Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ."

The objective is "to build a revival dimension through seven strategic phases" accomplishing four important goals:





### **DNA – The Building Blocks Of Life**

Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) is a nucleic acid present in the cells of all living organisms. It is often referred to as the "building blocks of life" since DNA encodes the genetic material that determines the development of an organism. In addition to maintaining the genetic blueprints for its parent organism, DNA also performs a number of other functions which are critical to life.

This nucleic acid was first identified in 1889, when researcher Friedrich Miescher found a substance he called "nuclein" in human cells. In the early 20th century, several researchers including Phoebus Levene and William Astbury performed additional research on "nuclein," beginning to understand its components, structure, and role in life.

### **DNA – Acts 1:8**

Acts 1:8 (KJV) "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth."

Greek Word for Power: δύναμις

Vine's Words: Ability, Able, Meaning, Might (Noun), Mighty, Mightily, Mightier, Miracle, Power, Strength, Strengthen

### Power – DUNAMIS

The Greek Lexicon defines DUNAMIS as, "to have inherent power, the power residing in a thing by virtue of its nature, the power a person puts forth beyond our own strength."

### **DNA – DUNAMIS** is the God-Like Gene!

2 Peter 1:1-4 (KJV), "Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ: Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, According as his divine POWER (dunamis) hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust."



Through the Power (DuNAmis) we are given the origin of both LIFE and GODLINESS (*eusebeia* -The Gospel Scheme).

We become partakers of the Divine (theios - Godlike) Nature (physis – growth through germination, the genus or gene)

### Divine Nature - Godlike Gene or DNA

When we are "born again" of water and Spirit, we are born of incorruptible seed or miraculous gene!

1 Peter 1:22-23 (KJV), "Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible (*aphthartos - Immortal*), by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever."

The power of God, given to us through the Holy Spirit, is the miraculous origin of all spiritual life. This divine God given gene possesses all the characteristics of revival and of spiritual fruit.

×

John 1:12, "But as many as received him, to them gave he power (exhousia - ability) to become (ginomai - assembled into) the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name."

Faith in Christ is more than a mental decision. True faith initiates a transformation in the heart of the believer. The exact moment of "Faith in Christ" could be compared to the "Big Bang." In other words, this is the very moment the creative process begins. Faith is then the seed of spiritual conception and obedience to the gospel is the spiritual birth or the "New Birth" experience.

Through the Holy Spirit baptism during the "New Birth" the DNA of Christ likeness is born in the believer and subsequently in the church.

### **DNA** The Building Blocks Of Revival

Revival is not an accident. At least, it is not supposed to be. There is a blueprint for building the revival dimension. Of course, this is a *SPIRITUAL* dimension, therefore the building blocks themselves are spiritual. This study is an attempt at determining the essential components of every revival. These most basic components are the DNA of Revival.

# The DNA is the blueprint that determines the development of the revival.

Although there may be many diverse environments and participants, the revival itself will contain these essential elements. The code for these elements is called 7P3 because there are seven essential phases, principles and processes. The phases are major characteristics, the principles are based on the Word of God and the processes are practical applications.

### **Seven Prophetic Phases**

The phases are referred to as "prophetic" because built into each phase is the divine intention to birth the next phase.

### **The Vision**



### **Momentum**


Momentum is, "the impetus and driving force gained by the development of a process, or course of events."

# Momentum is created through a series of positive events happening simultaneously.

- Begin by starting a cycle. Initiate each phase one by one in sequence until they are all operating simultaneously.
- Once momentum is achieved, there is a certain energy provided by the combinations of elements.
- The revival strategy becomes focused on maintaining a proper balance among all the important elements.
- The DNA of Revival provides a template you may use to diagnose the general health of the Revival.
- Throughout the process it may become necessary to apply more emphasis on certain phases that have become weak due to some unexpected circumstance.



# Consecration



The term "consecration" to many is "old fashioned." In the Bible, this term is found most often in the Old Testament in reference to items that are "to be set apart" as holy for the purposes of worshipping God. It is also used to describe the setting apart of the priests, who are to be consecrated to the Lord. Although the word is not used extensively in the New Testament, it occurs in reference to the consecrated bread, and is applied to individuals and the purposes of God.

The deepest most meaningful manner in which we express our willingness to give ourselves away to Christ forms the foundation of consecration. The desire of one who longs after Christ, is to submerge themselves in Him until we are *in* this world, but not *of* this world.


Charles Spurgeon was saved on January 6, 1850, and on February 1 he wrote the following prayer of consecration: "O great and unsearchable God, who knowest my heart, and triest all my ways; with a humble dependence upon the support of Thy Holy Spirit, I yield up myself to Thee; as Thy own reasonable sacrifice, I return to Thee Thine own. I would be for ever, unreservedly, perpetually Thine; whilst I am on earth, I would serve Thee; and may I enjoy Thee and praise Thee for ever! Amen." (Wycliffe Handbook of Preaching & Preachers, W. Wiersbe, p. 235)

New dimensions in the Spirit of God begin in consecration. We must separate from this world and develop a sense of the sacred nature of kingdom living. Every sacrifice made in pursuit of spiritual growth will bring eternal rewards.



Toward the end of her life, I was privileged to hear Nona Freeman, the life long missionary to Africa, make a very powerful statement that I have never forgotten. "Faith cometh by REVELATION" she said, "And REVELATION by the Word of God" This is an obvious quoting of Romans 10:17 inserting the word "revelation" in place of "hearing." This statement opened up a world of understanding in my mind. It's not just hearing the Word, but rather, it is having the Word revealed with a depth of understanding that defines Faith.



Phase Three **Demonstration** 








The early church was born in "demonstration" of the power of God; not through great public speaking, theological debate, or human charisma. Their strength was not in magnificent buildings with large sprawling campuses. Nor did they rely upon enlarging bank accounts and influential connections.

The Apostle Paul wrote plainly, "And my speech, and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power. That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (I Corinthians 2:4-5) Furthermore, Paul said, "the Kingdom of God is not in word, but in power." (I Corinthians 4:20)


Jesus left the church with the great mission of reaching the world with the Gospel of the Kingdom. This task will not be accomplished by mere words alone. As in the early church, the church today must understand her authority in Christ and must be armed with the God given tools and keys to demonstrate the power of God. This includes the operation of Spiritual gifts within the body, a fully functioning five-fold ministry as well as various signs, wonders and miracles occurring as the Spirit itself directs. They . . . "went forth and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the Word with signs following." (Mark 16:20)

This is God's method for effective ministry and the Lord working with us, confirming His Word with miraculous signs. The world is attracted to Jesus when they see visible results of the power of the Gospel that changes lives. There is tremendous power available to each and every believer through the Holy Ghost Baptism.



Phase Four **Evangelization** 








To evangelize means, "to proclaim the good news of the gospel of Christ." In Romans 1:14 Paul states, "I am a debtor both to the Greeks and to the Barbarians, both to the wise and to the unwise." In like manner, today we are debtors to every non-Christian because we have the good news that can save the soul. This places us under obligation to share the gospel with the lost so they can be saved.

If people have not heard and learned the gospel they cannot obey it. In 1 Peter 4:17 the question is asked, "What shall be the end of those who do not obey the gospel?" The answer is given in 2 Thessalonians 1:8 which says when the Lord comes He will come "In flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ." We should not want to see anyone lost but as Paul says in 2 Corinthians 5:11, "Knowing the terror of the Lord we persuade men."


In the first century the good news of the gospel caused great excitement. "And daily in the temple and from house to house they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus." (Acts 5:42). We need to be as excited today. And even when they were being heavily persecuted, some even to death, we read in Acts 8:4, "Therefore those who were scattered abroad went everywhere preaching the word." What should stop us today? We are not being persecuted. We have many more advantages including the automobile, the airplane, the telephone, the Internet, and the printed page. We are without excuse.

Reaching the lost is the work the Lord has commanded each of us to do. Successful evangelism is best accomplished one person at a time. Evangelism is not only to be done in distant lands. We must also teach those near us, our next door neighbors, our family and friends. God will be with us as we teach His word to the lost. "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."

Phase Five **Transformation** 







The character of Christ will produce the conduct of Christ. Perhaps this, in part, is the reason Paul proclaimed in Galatians 4:19, "I travail in birth again until Christ be formed in you." We need the very nature of Christ to shape our character. The Word must touch who we are and transform the very core of our being. When we begin to become one with Christ, His divine nature leads and transforms our lives.

This leads us to our role, which is to model Christ-like character, encouraging others to surrender themselves to Jesus Christ (Gal. 2:20-21). The Apostle Paul lived a life worthy of examination and provides a model for a transformed life.

His conversion was dramatic and transforming. He became committed unto death, suffering much along the way as he lived out his convictions. By his own words he was a servant of Christ and a servant to all. He went so far as to describe himself as the "prisoner" of Christ. The maturing minister became a bold leader among the very Christians he had once persecuted, declaring "follow me as I follow Christ" Finally, near the end of a life-long walk with the Lord he announced victory in his struggle against sin and evil. He said, "I have finished my course, I have kept the faith!"


Paul's conversion, commitment, character, calling, and crown all documented a transformed life. He had come a long way since carrying letters to persecute the church and standing by while they stoned Steven! This is the essence of Transformation, becoming a new creature through purposeful discipleship.

Let us now put on Christ and further the purpose of our salvation. We are ever leaving darkness and entering light. His marvelous light and abundant life!

- **Legacy** 2 Timothy 4:6-8, Perhaps the most famous speech concerning ones own passing in the scripture. Paul sums it all up and declares victory in the faith!

Phase Six Multiplication





"I am the vine, ye *are* the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing." (John 15:5)

As disciples of Jesus, we are to Him, as branches are to the vine. Bearing fruit is our primary responsibility as branches. This of course is only accomplished by drawing strength and nourishment from the vine itself. The vine (JESUS) is the source of all the essential elements in producing fruit.


In the process of bearing fruit, we experience the "abundant life" that Jesus offers which is described as the fruit of the Spirit. "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law." (Galatians 5:22-33) All of these amazing attributes are experienced in the process of bringing forth the fruit of Christ likeness.

Fruit is brought forth as we live our lives. Fruit is a result of living. Therefore everything we say, do, think and feel, as well as where we go impacts our eventual fruitfulness.


There is a strong warning in the scripture, against a lack of fruitfulness, displayed in the example of Jesus cursing the fig tree.

"He spake also this parable; A certain *man* had a fig tree planted in his vineyard; and he came and sought fruit thereon, and found none. <sup>7</sup> Then said he unto the dresser of his vineyard, Behold, these three years I come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and find none: cut it down; why cumbereth it the ground? <sup>8</sup> And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung *it*: <sup>9</sup> And if it bear fruit, *well*: and if not, *then* after that thou shalt cut it down." (Luke 13:6-9)

Phase Seven **Restoration** 





One of the definitions of renewal, the one that mostly applies to Christianity, is "the conversion of waste land into land suitable for use of habitation or cultivation." The "living waters" of the Holy Spirit convert the dry spiritual wastelands of our soul into fertile ground that produces good fruit.

"For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring: And they shall spring up as among the grass, as willows by the water courses." (Isaiah 44:3-4)


The baptism of the Holy Ghost at once converts the dry soul into a river of living water and establishes a well to continue springing up unto eternal life. The well is a constant source of supply. The well of water is there for the dry seasons when daily rain is not readily available.

Perhaps the greatest, most powerful force of Christianity is the resurrection of Jesus Christ. The resurrection brings back Jesus from the dead and renews the faith of wavering disciples. This power, this "resurrection power "is embedded deep within the Christian life.


The nature of humanity and everything in the natural world is to slowly degrade in quality over time. Food spoils, metal rusts, wood rots, clothes fade, etc ... This happens to us spiritually, simply because we have this treasure in earthen vessels. The Holy Spirit is the source of renewal. Each phase of the "revival" dimension may be renewed over and over again!

The revival processes will be sustainable as long as they are renewable!









#### Restoration

- Brought back into proper fellowship with the Lord
- Washed and cleansed from sin, backsliding and failure

#### Resurrection

- To give something new life and vitality
- Bringing into activity and prominence once again
- To raise up from the dead or from a state of deadness or inactivity

#### **Sustaining Process**

- To strengthen or support physically or mentally
- Provide with nourishment
- Cause to continue or be prolonged for an extended period of time or to go without interruption



"Wilt thou not revive us again; that thy people may rejoice in thee?" (Psalms 85:6)

"Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold all things are become new." (2 Corinthians 5:17)
